Budget: Go over the draft budget line for line. Billings reported that brush and wood has increased at the transfer station and it therefore has cost more money to dispose of the ash accumulated. Duncan suggested that a gate should be put up and vehicles with brush, or demo would have to check in with attendants. They could check for stickers and charge where necessary. Decided to table budget till next meeting. Duncan went over possible transfers from surplus to various reserve accounts and suggested the elimination of the old broadband reserve account into another account. Decisions tabled till next meeting.

Projects: Oceanville project going well, barriers are out in case of another storm. School building moving forward, carpenter is working on inside, contract has been signed for spec's on elevator so it can go out to bid. Main Street is a mess, water in town turned off twice, contractor has encountered a lot of ledge and stone. T-Buck is almost finished with the new water line project
