ITEM 1: Minutes October 2024 Moved Web second Turner to accept Vote 3-0-2
 December 2024 Moved Boyce second Eaton Vote 4-0-1

ITEM 2: Financials Harbor Approximately \$30,000 not spent will move to reserve
 Moved Turner second Boyce to accept Vote 5-0
 Fish Pier Approximately \$39,000 not spent will move to reserve
 Moved Boyce second Web to accept Vote 5-0

ITEM 3: Harbormaster report New motherboard for fuel system has arrived but old is
 now working so will keep new one for spare.
 Eric Bubar is not renewing punt or parking. Still over
 booked for punt space but have rented parking space.
 Staples still owes for punt so he has lost his space

ITEM 4: Loading dock Dana Web reported that he has a lot to do to prepare on
 Loading dock before removal. Duncan reported that the
 road crew could possibly cut it up but sander in truck will
 make removal difficult. Boyce suggested Buster might
 be able to remove dock. Dana web will get quote from
 Buster. Dana Web suggested that it might be better to
 wait until end March first April to remove dock this
 would be better from his standpoint. Board agreed that
 that would be OK as loading dock is not in way during
 winter

ITEM 5: Mooring Fees Duncan reported that the Selectmen wanted to know what
 category they considered businesses located in Stonington
 with moorings. Board stated that they pay town property
 tax they should be considered commercial residential.
 Boyce moved Eaton second that the fees for moorings
 should be \$100.00 commercial residential, \$200.00
 commercial non-resident, \$200 pleasure residential (this
 includes summer residents with property tax Stonington),
 \$400.00 pleasure nonresident. Vote 4-1
